There is a wide gap between what can currently be recognized and extracted from music audio signals and the kinds of high-level, semantically meaningful concepts that human listeners associate with music. In this workshop, an overview of computational models in the context of the music of specific cultures including Indian classical music will be presented. Signal processing and machine learning tools for music information research will be introduced. A panel discussion involving technologists and musicologists on relevant problems in music computation is planned.
