

FIRST AID – HF Acid

Eye Contact:

Check for and remove any contact lenses. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes with plenty of water for at least 15-30 minutes. Cold water may be used. Keep the eyelids apart and away from the eyeballs. **Do not use oily drops or ointment or HF skin burn treatments on the eyes.**

Get medical attention immediately, preferably an eye specialist.

Skin Contact:

In case of contact, immediately flush skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes while removing contaminated clothing and shoes. Cold water may be used. **Get medical attention immediately.**

Flush the affected area with water for one minute and then massage **Calcium Gluconate Cream** into the affected area until there is a cessation of pain (available in refrigerator of Micro1 lab).

Inhalation:

If inhaled, remove to fresh air. **Get medical attention immediately.**

Ingestion:

If swallowed, do not induce vomiting. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Loosen tight clothing.

Get medical attention immediately.
